Hi Nathan,

Thanks so much for your message.

Basically, I can't compare my project to any of those vetted by GiveWell, but the thing is: none of the charities vetted by GiveWell are working anywhere in my region (Kamuli & Buyende), a vast region spanning over 3,300 square kilometers, and where people are living in the direst conditions imaginable.

To be fair, I know of Village Enterprise, as being one of the charities that have been vetted by GiveWell, and I am aware Village Enterprise is present in Uganda, but not anywhere near my region -- just like all the other charities that have been vetted by GiveWell; The Life You Can Save; Giving What We Can etc.

So, as one of the people who are only emerging from chronic poverty and starvation, and who lives in a place where practically nothing is happening to end extreme poverty, I don't really think I must wait for these people to come.

But I wholeheartedly support your standpoint. Please don't feel obliged to do anything. I just wanted to enquire.
